Caravan continues to deliver food to St. Eulalia/Sacred Heart

The rain and wind held off until 6:30 pm on Tuesday, October 20 -- just as the weekly St. Eulalia Quinn Center food pantry finished up for the day. One hundred fourteen families, representing 420 people, received groceries that day. The need has not been abated.

Did you ever wonder what it looks like in a food pantry's preparation area? Each Sunday our Divine Savior caravan team brings groceries and fills bags for the next Tuesday. They make sure there are enough bags for anticipated need - - and then make more. Some will be used during the week for homebound delivery or unplanned needs; others will be used the following week. The pictures here show what's left after all the bags are filled. The Quinn Center staff and our teams check the remaining inventory to be sure shoppers can target the items most needed to round out the supply for next week.

1. Grab an empty box or container and add the items on the list each day (let us know if you need a box – we're happy to drop one off to you - we have lots!)
2. Shop for the items all at once, put them in the box and you're done!
3. Overwhelmed with work, school, kids, and/or just this 2020 life in general?! Just send \$30 and we will shop/fill a box in your name!
4. From out of town but still want to help make an impact? Send \$30 and we will shop/fill a box in your name!

Think about that number from last year one more time....700 boxes?! Please consider joining us in the effort to make Thanksgiving an enjoyable meal for so many others in need. Your 1 box DOES make a difference! We have tons of boxes to pass out so please let us know if you'd like one (or more)!

At the center of our faith is the conviction that God loves us and calls us to love one another. 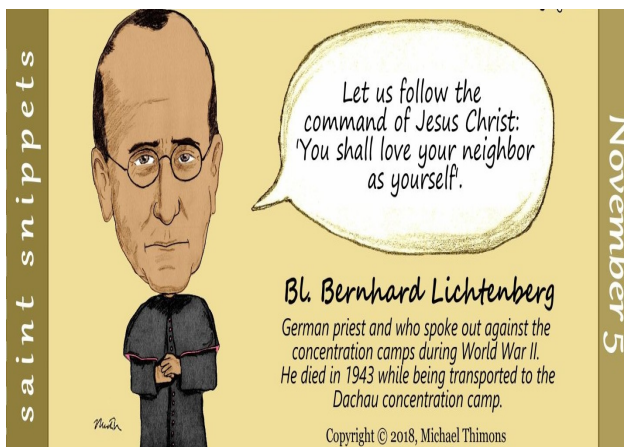
