THANKSGIVING FOOD DRIVE



As the month of November and Thanksgiving approaches, we often reflect with gratitude on our blessings and good fortune. While we reflect on all we have to be thankful for, let's also remember that many of our neighbors are feeling the pain of need more than ever this year. This is a good time for us all to think about those who are less fortunate and consider how we can help.

We'd like to give you just that – a concrete way that you can directly help those in need! There is such a great need for food donations all year long but during the season of Thanksgiving, many food pantries see an incredible rise in need.

In 2019, St. Eulalia passed out Thanksgiving Food Boxes to OVER 700 FAMILIES. Yes, you read that correctly...700! We're asking for your help as we strive to fulfill what we know will be another major year of need for them, especially with the current pandemic.

These families are dependent on the generosity of volunteers and donors like you. We challenge you to fill a box of food during the month of November using this calendar of suggested items. Most of these items are things you probably already have in your pantry at home! The items you see in the picture posted here fulfill this list and were all purchased at Aldi for about \$30!

There are so many ways to participate and make a difference! Have kids at home? This is the perfect opportunity to get them involved and help them learn more about the importance of giving back! Here are just a few ways you can fulfill this challenge:

1. Grab an empty box or container and add the items on the list each day (let us know if you need a box – we're happy to drop one off to you - we have lots!)
2. Shop for the items all at once, put them in the box and you're done!
3. Overwhelmed with work, school, kids, and/or just this 2020 life in general?! Just send \$30 and we will shop/fill a box in your name!
4. From out of town but still want to help make an impact? Send \$30 and we will shop/fill a box in your name!

Think about that number from last year one more time....700 boxes?! Please consider joining us in the effort to make Thanksgiving an enjoyable meal for so many others in need. Your 1 box DOES make a difference! We have tons of boxes to pass out so please let us know if you'd like one (or more)!

Caravan continues to deliver food to St. Eulalia/Sacred Heart

Tuesday's deluge of rain was preceded by a deluge of people at St. Eulalia's Quinn Center. Grocery bags were distributed to 111 families -- 493 people. That's the largest number of family members served in one week since the pandemic food pantry began last March. They even ran short on bagged meals! Fortunately, all groceries were distributed *before* the deluge came!



Graham Greene's classic *The Power and the Glory* immortalized Mexico's persecuted Church of the 1920s. But photographs of Father Pro—arms outstretched to image Christ Crucified, kneeling in prayer before the firing squad, crumpled dead on the ground—vividly, visually remind us that not long ago, not far away, the faith we take for granted cost everything! Born to a mining family, Miguel became a Jesuit and was sent to study Catholic labor movements in Belgium in preparation for evangelizing Mexico's workers. But he returned to find a Mexico determined to annihilate Catholicism, and, like priests before him during Roman persecutions, England's Reformation, and in China today, ministered secretly to an "underground Church" until apprehended and sentenced to the firing squad. In his final moments, Father Pro blessed his executioners, forgave his enemies, and shouted: "Viva el Cristo Rey!—Long Live Christ the King!"—his defiant, dying proclamation of ultimate, transcendent loyalty. Father Pro's martyrdom reinvigorated that beleaguered Church, whose countless faithful, never again afraid, would throng John Paul II when he visited Pro's beloved Mexico fifty-two years later.
