An Important Message about Christmas Giving and our Sharing Parish Saint Eulalia

Saint Eulalia Parish, as part of the diocesan-wide effort to restructure parishes for greater vibrancy and viability, has now merged with Sacred Heart Parish in Melrose Park. Their new name is Sacred Heart and Saint Eulalia Parish. Please be aware of how this newly formed parish will impact our Christmas gift giving to them from the wish tags placed on our *Advent Giving Tree* in the following ways:



- ◆ **We will have to be even more generous than ever** gifting their families at Christmas because **there will be one hundred fifty (150) gift tags for Sacred Heart-Saint Eulalia on the Giving Tree** since their newly merged community is so much larger and includes their communities from both their faith formation programs (70) and additional parish families (80) (and we are only one of several parishes that share with them because there is so much need there). So please be as generous as you can seeing to it that no child is left without a gift this Christmas.;
- ◆ **We will have to have our gifts returned for delivery to them at an earlier date.** We will make this as easy as possible for all of you by putting up our *Giving Tree* one week earlier than usual, the November 24th weekend, the Solemnity of Christ the King, the last Sunday of our Church year before the new Church year begins with the First Sunday of Advent, November 30th-December 1st weekend.;
- ◆ **All gifts for Sacred Heart-Saint Eulalia Parish will have to be returned to the vestibule by Friday December 13th the latest** so they can be delivered on Saturday December 14th in time for their Christmas party on Sunday December 15th. Please make certain if you take a tag to return it with a gift by that date so no child goes home without the gift intended for them.

Thank you for your goodness, your constant generosity and your support always of this sharing tradition for our faith community that makes the real Christmas of Christ's love visible for all to see among us.
